SPECIAL Master Gardener Created Plant Kits

by Claire Hansen, Community Conservationist, Hubbard County Soil and Water Conservation District (HCSWCD)

One of the challenges of living and gardening in Northern Minnesota is finding plants that are suitable for Zone 3 and with some areas of challenging sandy soils. We worked with University of Minnesota staff Tarah Young and our local chapter of Master Gardeners to create two kits specialized for native prairie and pollinaters in Hubbard County.

The first kit is a full sun collection called **Short Grass Prairie Starter Kit**. This will provide pollinators and birds a tasty snack and your garden with three seasons of interest with stems and seed heads that will stand up throughout the winter.

Kit #1 Short Grass Prairie Starter Kit: Prairie Dropseed, Little Bluestem, Big Bluestem, Purple Coneflower, Black Eyed Susan, Butterfly Milkweed

The second kit is a full sun collection called **Summer/Fall Pollinator Kit.** This will provide pollinators with a colorful buffet from summer into fall.

Kit #2 Summer/Fall Pollinator Kit: Anise Hyssop, Showy Goldenrod, Rough Blazing Star, Purple Coneflower, Black Eyed Susan, Butterfly Milkweed
